Ligustrum japonicum 'Recurvifolium'

- <u>Use:</u> Finer texture and more compact growth than regular wax. Densely branched habit with glossy foliage responds well to pruning into topiary or small standard trees. Displays profusion of white blooms in late spring. Useful hedge, screen or windbreak.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full/part shade; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer.
- <u>Growth:</u> Fast grower to 8 to 10 feet tall, 4 to 6 feet wide. Upright growth habit, dark green foliage with slightly wavy leaf edges.
- *Hardiness:* 5-9; Shrub, Small Tree
- <u>Foliage</u>: Evergreen; dark green_foliage.
- Flower: White, fragrant flowers in the spring-summer.
