- <u>Use:</u> Jazz Hands Dwarf Pink Loropetalum has cool purple foliage with a cranberry undercurrent. It combines beautifully with the hot pink blooms. This showy little dwarf plant fits easily into residential landscapes and container gardens, and is a great match with Jazz Hands Dwarf White.
- Exposure/Soil: Full (best leaf color)-part sun. Best in moist, well-drained, acidic soil. Fertilize in spring. Pruning is seldom needed, but may be shaped after flowering. Extra mulch around the base may be helpful in cooler climates.
- Growth: Moderate growing 3 to 5 feet tall and 3-5'wide.
- *Hardiness: Zones* 7-9, shrub
- Foliage: Evergreen. Foliage becomes bright red in fall.
- Flower: Dazzling hot pink fringed flowers illuminate the deep-colored leaves in spring.
