- <u>Use:</u> Jazz Hands Variegated® is the first ever variegated Loropetalum; its new growth is splashed with pink and white variegation, while mature foliage is a rich purple color. This distinctive plant may be used as a specimen or a hedging plant.
 - **Exposure/Soil:** Full (best foliage color)— part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- Growth: Moderate growing 4 to 6 feet tall and 4-5'wide.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 7-9, shrub
- Foliage: Evergreen. New growth is splashed with pink and white. Mature foliage is purple.
- **Flower:** The emergence of dark fuchsia frilly flowers in spring only add to the excitement this shrub brings to the garden.
