Nandina domestica 'Lemon-Lime' PP24749

- <u>Use</u>: 'Lemon Lime' is the first heavenly bamboo to have lime green new growth. The lime green leaves will brighten any dark space and add dimension to an otherwise evergreen planting. Disease and pest resistant.
- Exposure/Soil: Plant in full sun to partial sun. Will tolerate some shade, but will be less vibrant in chartreuse color. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- Growth: Dwarf habit 3 to 4 ft. tall and wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 6-9; Shrub
- Foliage: Evergreen. Each spring, the new growth emerges bright, limey chartreuse and then fades to grass green as the summer heats up.
- **Flower:** Tiny white flowers in spring, but not noticeable. Nearly fruitless cultivar so little worry of them spreading.
