Podocarpus macropyllus 'Maki'

- <u>Use:</u> A medium-sized variety of Yew Podocarpus that will accommodate smaller spaces, more ideal for foundation plantings.
 Slower growing than others with dense upright branching on a pyramidal form, heavily covered by small, dark green, needle-like foliage. A wonderful, low maintenance hedge or screen plant.
- Exposure/Soil: Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Slower growing version of the species, reaching only 8-10 ft. in height, 3-5 ft. wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 7-11; Shrub
- *Foliage:* Evergreen, 0.5 to 2.7 in. needle-like leaves arranged spirally; waxy, lustrous dark green; two wide bands below
- <u>Flower:</u> Not known for flowers. 1 to 1.5 in. male catkin-like flowers occur in clusters; 0.5 in. edible purple-red fruit on female plants
