- <u>Use</u>: A great deal of Double Knock Out's value as a landscape Rose comes from its four-season appeal and its resistance to blackspot, that scourge of other Roses! Not only is the bloom season exceptionally long, but the foliage takes on rich burgundy hues when it emerges in spring, adding another season of color to this shrub's merits!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. More tolerant of shade than 'Radrazz'
- **Growth**: Rounded, bushy and well-behaved shrub, fast growing 3 to 4 ft. high and wide. Smaller than 'Radrazz' (red single)
- Hardiness: 5-10 Shrub
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. Unsurpassed resistance to black spot leaf disease.
- <u>Flower:</u> These blooms of shiny fire-engine red are about 2 1/2 inches wide and utterly unstoppable from early summer till frost. Most are fully double, some semi-double, with an average petal count of 18 to 25. These blooms are all high-centered in the classic Rose form. No need to deadhead this lively shrub -- the flowers just keep coming no matter what!
