- <u>Use:</u> A cute little sphere of cheerful yellow foliage. It was developed in Canada, so you know that this little plant isn't bothered by winter weather and holds its color all year-round. This nifty little evergreen needs no pruning to keep its tight, rounded shape and makes a nice addition to perennial beds, rock gardens, troughs and containers, or any landscape project.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full/part sun; well-draining soil. Water may not puddle around plant, and appreciates slow release fertilizer twice a year. Water if it hasn't rained in 7-10 days first 2 years. Must amend the soil if you have red clay! We recommend our **Pro Mix** Soil!
- **Growth:** Slow growing 10-15" tall and wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 3-8; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Bright chartreuse foliage that persists through winter. Excellent burn resistance.
- **Flowers:** Neither the flowers nor the fruit are ornamentally significant.
