Thuja occidentalis 'Degroot's Spire'

- *Use:* A tall narrow arborvitae to separate multistory buildings. Twisted texture on pyramidal form tolerates shearing for a tailored column. Ideal for matched pairs, or lined up as screen hedge.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Slow growth to 20 ft. tall and 4 to 5 ft. wide.
- Hardiness: 5 -10 Shrub /Small tree.
- Foliage: Rich green foliage takes on purple cast in winter. Evergreen.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers..
