Stately hedge or specimen tree. Can also be used in pots around the home for a few years.

- <u>Use</u>: Talk about performance! Emerald Green exhibits excellent growth in any yard from Minnesota to southern Georgia and beyond. There is no need for pruning or shearing to get a full, robust tree. Ideal for matched pairs in pots for 2-3 years, or lined up as screen hedge.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full to part sun. During the winter they
 prefer well-drained soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in.
 of soil is dry. Once established needs only occasional water.
- Growth: Moderate growth to 12ft. tall and 4 to 5 ft. wide.
- Hardiness: 5 -10 Shrub /Small tree.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Holds its foliage color throughout winter. Evergreen.
- <u>Flower:</u> Not known for flowers...
