- <u>Use:</u> Narrow upright columnar habit is perfect for narrow sites as a specimen or screen. Little care is needed. Excellent landscape plant. More narrow than Emerald Green. Fast growing, with a handsome, dense habit. More narrow than Emerald Green. Selected by Art Boe of Faribault, MN, it is resistant to winter burn.
  - <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full to part sun. Water regularly- weekly, or more often in extreme heat. Needs less frequent watering, once established.
- **Growth**: quickly reaches 10-15 ft. tall and 3-5' wide.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 3a-8b; Shrub
- *Foliage:* Evergreen. Holds its dark green foliage color throughout winter. Hardy, resists winter burn.
- Flower: Not known for flowers...
