## Glitters & Glows® Arrowwood Viburnum









- <u>Use:</u> Breathe a sigh of relief. They've put All That Glitters® and All That Glows® viburnums TOGETHER in one pot! No more uncertainty about having to source a pollinator. Seeing beautiful bunches of blue berries in your fall garden has never been easier. Beautiful, low-maintenance, and elegant! The foliage of All That Glitters® and All That Glows® viburnum is super glossy, which gives them a hand-some presence in the landscape. Early summer brings hundreds of white flower clusters, which are followed by (guaranteed!) shiny blue fruit in fall. These versatile plants are smaller than most viburnums, which makes them perfectly suited to foundation plantings, hedges, screening, or as a distinctive specimen.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Easily grown in average, medium moisture, well-drained soils in full sun to part shade. Prefers moist loams, but tolerates a wide range of soils. Established plants have some drought tolerance. Prune as needed immediately after flowering. Tolerates clay and growing under black walnut trees.
- **Growth**: Quickly growing to 4-5' tall and wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 4a-8a; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Green toothed leaves. Fall colors vary from yellow to orange or red. Foliage is deer resistant, but deer will eat flowers.
- <u>Flower:</u> Non-fragrant white flowers in flat-topped corymbs (to 4" diameter) appear in late spring. Flowers give way to blue-black, berry-like drupes which are quite attractive to birds and wildlife. . Fantastic for wildlife gardens where birds can enjoy berries, wildlife will enjoy shelter, and pollinators feast on flowers.
