Shasta Viburnum



Treat your garden to an evergreen shrub that offers spring variegation,



fragrant flowers, and masses of berries beloved of birds and * other wildlife! Build a natural habitat around 'Shasta' Viburnum!

Viburnum plicatum tomentosum 'Shasta'

- <u>Use</u>: After staging a blizzard of outsized snowy blossoms in mid spring along elegantly layered horizontal branches, 'Shasta' comes back with a double encore.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. Requires well-drained soil and good moisture. Needs extra water during a drought.
- Growth: Grows 6-8 feet tall and 8-10 feet wide
- *Hardiness:* Zone 5-8; Shrub
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. The maple like leaves turn purple and red in the fall providing your with some incredible autumn foliage.
- <u>Flower:</u> In late spring fragrant white blooms (that butter-flies love) open up in lovely rounded lacecap like clusters.
 They give away to abundant bright read fruits in mid summer that provide a picnic for birds.
