Yucca Golden Sword





Yucca filamentosa 'Golden Sword'

- <u>Use:</u> Use this shrub to add contrasting form to mixed borders or to add four-season architectural interest to patio containers. When plants are illuminated by the slanting light of morning or evening, the radiant leaves bring a memorable glow to the garden. Like other Yuccas, these plants thrive in hot, dry conditions and will tolerate poor soil. Winner of the RHS Award of Garden Merit.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full sun. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** This is a smaller Yucca, being stemless or clump-forming, the height will max out at 2-3 feet with a 3' spread.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 4-10; Perennial.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Evergreen. Blue-green blades with a broad central stripe of golden yellow add dramatic form and color to the garden and container pots, and the evergreen foliage remains an attraction in all seasons.
- <u>Flower:</u> In summer, tall spikes emerge capped by multiple fragrant, bell-shaped ivory flowers.
