Variegated Yucca



Yucca gloriosa 'Variegata'

- <u>Use:</u> Striking when grouped in a low-water garden or spotted in flowering perennial beds for contrasting color and texture. Foliage clump develops a trunk after several years. Use to create contrasting textures as a garden accent or container plant. Excellent for use in areas where you can not water and have poor soil!
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full sun, but will take a little shade. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **<u>Growth</u>**: Grows to a height will max out at 2'(4' in flower) feet with a 20" spread.
- *Hardiness: Zone* 7-10; Perennial.
- *Foliage:* Evergreen. Rigid blue-green leaves are bordered with gold when new, gradually becoming rich cream.
- <u>Flower:</u> In late Spring to Early summer it will send up a spike of fragrant, creamy-white bell-shaped flowers, reaching up to 6 foot.
