Acer dissectum 'Crimson Queen'

- <u>Use:</u> Crimsom Queen is a lace leaf type Japanese Red Maple that sports branches of bright crimson-red which persist through out the entire growing season. Crimson Queen Maple fall color, is a deep scarlet red. This is a strong growing lace leaf tree with beautiful cascading branches.
- Exposure/Soil: Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Will not tolerate soggy or extremely dry soil.
- **Growth:** Mature at 8-10' tall by 10-12' wide. Growth habit is variable from upright rounded, horizontal-vased, or weeping pendulous, depending upon cultivar, and often becoming densely twiggy with age.
- *Hardiness:* 5-8, medium sized tree
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. The leaves are a medium delicate lacey dark red.
- **Flower:** Clusters of red to purplish inflorescences in late May and early June are often hidden by the foliage.
