- **Growth:** Vigorous, self-branching habit, reaching 15 to 20 feet tall and 8 to 12 feet wide. Excellent as a landscape specimen.
- *Hardiness: Zone 6*-10; Multi-stemmed shrub or small tree.
- Foliage: Deciduous In the fall, the foliage begins to fade from dark green to orange-red shades.
- <u>Flowers</u>: Deep scarlet-red blossoms throughout the summer. Flowering begins in July and will continue until frost.
