
Centennial Blush Magnolia

- <u>Use</u>: Centennial Blush Star Magnolia provides a fantastic floral display of fragrant, delicate pink flowers covering the entire plant in spring. Attractive medium green leaves on an interesting branching structure follows in summer which eventually turn shades of yellow and bronze in autumn. Well adapted to a variety of soils, Centennial Blush can be grown as a large shrub or a small tree and is perfectly suited for small urban gardens.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun, but tolerates part sun, and tolerates just about any well-drained garden soil.
- *Growth*: Grows 12-18' tall. Space 10-15' apart.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 4-9; Tree
- Foliage: Deciduous. Elongate leaves.
- <u>Flower:</u> Pink buds open to incredibly full & wonderfully fragrant pale pink flowers in spring. A prolific bloomer with flower buds formed at almost every node yielding a fantastic floral display of delicate pink covering the entire plant.
