Magnolia stellata 'Royal Star'

- <u>Use</u>: A fragrant first breath of spring! Popular for early blooming, Royal Star Magnolia produces silky pale pink buds that burst into magnificent double 3-5" white stars. Cut branches are great in arrangements. Trouble-free Japanese native. Enjoy this one-of-a-kind beauty!
 - <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full sun, but tolerates part sun, and tolerates just about any well-drained garden soil.
 - Growth: Grows 8-20' tall. Space 10-15' apart.
 - *Hardiness:* 4-9; Tree.
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. Elongate leaves.
- <u>Flower:</u> Scads of large mildly fragrant snowy-white double-flowers from mid-March through April before its leaves emerge.
