Ann Magnolia







- <u>Use</u>: There is nothing quite like the glow of the large, red purple, cupped flowers against the gray of our midspring skies. What is amazing is that 'Ann' doesn't stop there but keeps blooming intermittently throughout the summer. At 8 feet tall, it is an ideal small tree for an urban garden. Enjoy this one-of-a-kind beauty! Also known as Little Girl Magnolias.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full sun, but tolerates part sun, and tolerates just about any well-drained garden soil.
- <u>Growth</u>: Grows 8-10' tall. Space 10-12' apart. Has a charming, open branched habit on a narrow form.
- *Hardiness:* 4-9; Tree.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. Elongate leaves.
- **Flower:** Exquisite, 3 to 4 inch blooms are reddish purple outside and white inside and make their entrance in early spring before the foliage buds out.
