- They are ideal for small gardens.
- No matter how large or small the variety, magnolias should be sheltered from strong winds.



## *Magnolia × loebneri 'Merrill'*

- **Use:** Dr. Merrill Magnolia is bathed in stunning fragrant double white flowers, blushed with pink with yellow eyes at the ends of the branches in mid-spring before the leaves. Dr. Merrill Magnolia is a wonderful hybrid magnolia selection, known for its early spring bloom in froths of fragrant white flowers and picturesque habit of growth. This tree is fast-growing, very hardy, and flowers from a young age.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Grow in full sun. These trees can grow in any soil... no matter if its acidic, loamy, moist, rich, sandy, as long as it is well-drained.
- **Growth:** Reaches 10-15 feet tall and 12 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Small Tree./ Large Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. It has dark green foliage throughout the season. The pointy leaves turn coppery bronze in fall.
- **Flower:** Large star-like flowers have a pleasing light fragrance. Blooms at an early age. Flowers are fragrant and great used as cut flowers indoors.
