## Prunus x 'Snofozam'

- <u>Use</u>: Naturally weeping branches are covered with showy, snow white flowers on this magnificent, compact, hardy specimen for the landscape. Produces very few red-black ornamental fruit in summer. Very disease and insect resistant. A beautiful small yard tree. Exquisite in Japanese style or nature inspired gardens.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. It is tolerant of pollution and all soils except very wet or chalky. This is a stunning profuse flowering cherry tree that has received the RHS Award of Garden Merit and is well worthy of a space in any sized garden. They are not drought-tolerant, so proper watering is a must.
- **Growth:** Slowly reaches 8 to 15 ft. tall, 6 to 12 ft. wide in natural form.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 4-8; Tree
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green leaves (to 3 1/4" long) turn attractive shades of gold and orange in autumn.
- <u>Flower:</u> In the spring it produces masses of lightly scented pure white flowers along plentiful of weeping branches that may run almost to the ground unless pruned. Flowers give way to small, sparse, black, inedible fruits.
