## Cycas revoluta

- <u>Use:</u> So Easy to Grow! They will tolerate hottest sun and humidity. Looks amazing next to a pool or on your deck. Prefers to be root bound so leave it in the pot, if you plant it in the ground. Use for tropical accent and specimen. Bring indoors in the winter is best, but does have some cold hardiness in zone 8. Not for human or animal consumption.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly when top 3in of soil is dry. We recommend our Pro Mix Soil and some bark for a good mix.
- Growth: Extremely slow growing to 8 feet tall, 3 to 6 foot spread.
- Hardiness: Zone 8b-11; Houseplant; Tropical while they may be hardy in zone 8b without protection they will lose all their leaves which take a long time to grow back so we recommend bringing indoors or using very good winter protection when temps go below 30 degrees.
- **Foliage:** The leaves maybe 3 to 7 feet long and 10 inches wide, depending on the age of the plant. The fronds grow in a circular pattern that creates a rosette pattern.
- **Flowers:** They do not flower, but produce cones with exposed seeds (gymnosperm), much like pines and fir trees.
