- <u>Use:</u> An evergreen vine with small, leathery, dark green leaves. Vigorous-growing, clinging, dense branches will adhere to any surface. A handsome choice for climbing walls, poles, arbors and fences.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water when top 3 in of soil is dry.
- <u>Growth</u>: Fast-growing to 25 to 30 ft. long.
  - <u>Hardiness</u>: 7-9; Vine. We recommend you plant them on a protected wall away from extreme winter cold. We have had ours for 10 years, however, with no problems!
- Foliage: Glossy evergreen leaves.
- **Flowers:** Flowers have little ornamental value.

Great for covering up walls or as a • dense groundcover in shade.
