- <u>Use</u>: If you've grown a hydrangea vine before, perhaps it took a bit longer to bloom than you had expected. With Flirty Girl™ that worry is a thing of the past! You'll get an abundance of lightly fragrant, creamy blooms in no time at all. New growth emerges purple, which adds to its charm in the landscape.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Plant in part shade with afternoon shade from our hot summer sun preferred. Blooms on old wood. Soil pH does not affect flower color. Best planted on a North facing wall.
- **Growth**: Slow growing to 40-50 feet high. Plant 6-9' apart.
- *Hardiness*: Zone 5-9 Vine
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. Coarsely toothed, glossy, dark-bluegreen leaves. Young purple shoots add to its interest.
- Flower: Large, flat-topped, lace cap hydrangea-like clusters (8 -10" across) of creamy white flowers which bloom in summer.
