- <u>Use</u>: Bigger flowers. Elegant and distinctive, Rose Sensation[™] is the perfect choice for gardeners who want something a little different in their landscapes. This is a showier variety with larger deeper pink sepals in June and July. Some deer resistance.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Plant in part shade with afternoon shade from our hot summer sun preferred. Blooms on old wood. Soil pH does not affect flower color. Best planted on a North facing wall.
- **Growth**: Slow growing to 40-50 feet high. Plant 6-9' apart.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 5-9 Vine
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. Coarsely toothed, glossy, dark-blue-green leaves. Young purple shoots add to its interest.
- <u>Flower:</u> Large, flat-topped, lace cap hydrangea-like clusters (8-10" across) of light to dark pink flowers which bloom in summer.
