## Trachelospermum jasminoides 'Madison'

- <u>Use:</u> A slightly more cold hardy form of the popular vining or spreading vine. Beautiful evergreen vine prized for its very fragrant, star-shaped white flowers. Train on posts, walls, or trellises, or use as a fast-growing shrubby ground cover. Can also be grown in a container.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water when top 3 in of soil is dry.
- <u>Growth</u>: Vine with 18 to 20 feet twining branches 1 to 2 feet tall.
- *Hardiness:* 7-9; Shrub / Vine
- *Foliage*: Glossy evergreen leaves.
- *Flowers:* Fragrant blossoms in the summer.
