

Tulip Top Parrot



- **Planting density:** 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- **Planting depth:** 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.
- **Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.**

Tulipa 'Top Parrot'

- **Use:** This unusual beauty is very hard to find and a true collector's tulip. No spring garden should be without this beauty. Beds, rock gardens, in patio planters, and woodland gardens. For a show-stopping attraction in your garden, plant tulips in a group of 30 to 60.

Exposure/Soil: Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.

- **Growth:** Grows 16-20" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8 Perennial Bulb
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long strap like leaves.
- **Flower:** Glossy, ruby red parrot iced in deep magenta in lower parts of petals; striking green base and ruffled parrot edges in bud stage relatively smooth petal edges in open stage.
