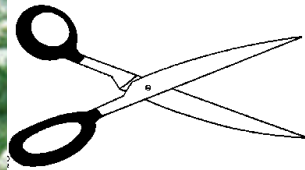


White Astilbe

- **Use:** The icy flowers blush with age to pale pink while contrasting beautifully with the reddish stems and deep, dark bronze-green infused foliage. This perennial thrives in moist, shady locations and is popular for border plantings or alongside water areas. One of the very best white astilbes. Very pretty with small to medium size gold-leaved hostas like Gold Standard. Plant in groups for maximum impact. Great for use in planters and in the garden! Deer resistant and nice for cutflowers.
- **Exposure/Soil: Prefers part sun!** Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Prefers to be kept moist and likes rich soil. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Grows 20-24" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** 4-9 perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter. Make sure they have well drained soil in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Distinctive reddish-bronze foliage.
- **Flower:** Has foamy, full white plumes that have a pink glow and semi-glossy foliage.
