Bellis perenne 'Bellissima'

- **Use:** Completely covering the compact plants, they thrive in the partly shaded garden and in containers of all types. The plants reach just 5 to 8 inches tall and wide, with large, dark green foliage held below the bright blooms. A fine choice for baskets, windowboxes, and patio containers, this mix also works well in the garden, nestled among the spring bulbs and early bloomers. Here in the south, they are grown during the cool-season, where they will bloom through winter among the Snaps and Pansies. Yet, they will reseed and come back every year. English Daisies are not difficult to grow. They thrive in climates where nights are cold and summers are mild.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun(best) to part light shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Prefers moist, humus rich soil.
- **Growth:** Quickly growing to 18" tall and continues to clump.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Daisies in all shades of pink, rose, red, and white!
