

# Siberian Bugloss



**An excellent, deer resistant woodland plant for shaded areas.**

## ***Brunnera macropylla***

- **Use:** These cousins to the Forget-me-nots are little-known, yet delightful for their bright display of sky-blue flowers in spring, and reliable clumps of large heart-shaped leaves all season. Makes for an attractive and versatile groundcover, particularly under shrubs. Clumps may be easily divided in early fall.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plants are happy in any shady area that stays relatively moist, but well-drained. Use a slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-18" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** 3-8; Perennial; Often will self-seed and appear around the garden in other places.
- **Foliage:** Glaucous leaves are lobed.
- **Flower:** Tiny, baby blue flowers dance above the foliage in the spring and make excellent cut flowers.
