

# Santa Fe Yellow Coreopsis



## *Coreopsis grandiflora* 'Santa Fe Yellow'

- **Use:** Looks great with any type of grass, in borders or mass plantings in sunny gardens. A multitude of flowers for early summer color in the full/part sun garden, container, or mass planting. Deer resistant, drought tolerant, and attracts butterflies.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full-part sun It's fairly drought tolerant and needs little water. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter.
- **Growth:** Grows has a plant height of 16" and a spread of 10-12". Shorter than many other cultivars.
- **Hardiness:** 4-9 perennial. Very heat and drought tolerant!
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The dark green thread leaf foliage makes a great contrast with the flower color.
- **Flower:** Semi-double 1- to 2-inch yellow flowers from June-September. It should be cut backing early and late summer to extend the bloom period.
