

Bright Star Coneflower



Echinacea purpurea 'Leuchtstern' (Bright Star)

- **Use:** As a specimen, in borders, or massed. Good choice for meadow or prairie gardens. Deer resistant, drought tolerant, and attracts butterflies.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Grows 2-3' tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Long oval leaves. Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Prominent, copper-orange central cones surrounded by red-purple ray petals up to 5 inches across are great as cut flowers.
