

Blanket Flower Goblin



Gaillardia x grandiflora 'Goblin' (G. x g. 'Kobold')

- **Use:** Useful, dwarf perennial with dazzling daisy-like flowers in the colors of an Indian blanket. The large blooms cover the top of this plant all season long. Thrives in sun and heat, nice touch in the rock garden or border.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Flower stalks to only 12 in. tall, mounds to 18 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. The flowers top mounds of roughly textured gray-green leaves
- **Flower:** Appearing summer through fall are large daisy-like flower heads; petals are rich maroon edged in yellow and surround red disk florets.

Easy to grow wildflower!
