Leucanthemum x superbum 'Alaska'

- **Use:** An outstanding dwarf form with large, single, long-lasting, pure white flowers that attract butterflies. Excellent for perennial borders, and containers. Resistant to heat, drought and humidity.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 12" tall, 15 –18" tall in bloom. Spreads to 20" width.
- **Hardiness:** 4-9 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Green leaves. Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Single white flowers late spring to summer. Cut off old flowers to promote more flowering.
