

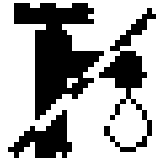
Golden Spider Lily

Lycoris aurea

- **Use:** Also known as Magic Lilies. Just as summer color vanishes, this elegant member of the Amaryllis family arrives to rejuvenate the garden! With lovely trumpet-shaped, plentiful blooms, Lycoris thrives in sunny spots with good drainage — just plant and forget! Prefers wet winters and hot, dry summers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant when established, but prefers moist, soil, but must be well-drained.
- **Growth:** Grows 2 feet tall.
- **Hardiness:** 7-10 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. After the flowers, grassy foliage arises and stays attractive all winter.
- **Flower:** Five to six golden-yellow blooms per head, shining brilliantly on 12-inch stems.
