Pulmonaria 'longiflora 'Roy Davidson'

- **Use:** This durable groundcover is valued for its ornamental foliage and blue flowers. Has an attractive mounding habit and long, narrow blue-green leaves speckled with silver. It will carpet the ground in shady beds and under deciduous trees. A fine blooming companion for spring blooming Daffodils and a great foliar foil in front of Geranium sanguineum in partial shade beds.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Perform best in compost-enriched soils with regular irrigation.
- **Growth:** Grows to 14" tall and 28" wide
- **Hardiness:** 4-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long narrower blue/green leaves are splashed with dots of silver. Plants should be cut back hard immediately after blooming, to rejuvenate the leaves, which will then remain attractive all season. Evergreen in mild winter regions. Clumps may be easily divided in early fall.
- **Flower:** Blooming in early spring with showy sprays of bluebell-shaped flowers.
