***Pulmonaria officinalis* 'Sissinghurst White'**

- **Use:** Lungworts are among the most dependable and showy spring-blooming perennials, and many types have attractive foliage throughout the season. This selection features clusters of clear white bells, the green leaves are lightly spotted in silver.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Perform best in compost-enriched soils with regular irrigation.
- **Growth:** Grows to 14" tall and 28" wide
- **Hardiness:** 4-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Extra large silver leaf spots on mounding foliage. Plants should be cut back hard immediately after blooming, to rejuvenate the leaves, which will then remain attractive all season. Evergreen in mild winter regions. Clumps may be easily divided in early fall.
- **Flower:** Blooming in early spring with clean white flower bells.
